Road Closure Update

NIXON— The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Transportation Planning Department has been working with the Federal Highways Administration; Emergency Repairs for Federally Owned Roads program (ERFO) to re-construct the flood damaged drainage areas along Surprise Valley Road at the north end of Pyramid Lake. The work has been ongoing for approximately 13 weeks. We are pleased to announce that the work has been completed on the 9 major sites along this route and the road is now open to the public.

As always we encourage our visitors to drive safe on this unpaved stretch of road and maintain a safe speed to ensure that you arrive at your destination safely.

Thank you to all who worked to get this project completed and the traveling public for your patience in waiting for the road to be reopened.

The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has indefinitely closed some roads on the reservation due to vandalism and cultural importance to the members of the Tribe. There is ample access to the lake via other routes and the Tribe invites you to come and explore beautiful Pyramid Lake.
